It will give those attending an opportunity to visit the projects carried out by Members of the UK-Uganda Network in support of the Uganda Scouts Association, their Members and Communities in which they live. The opportunity to see of how, for example, having visited Uganda in 2000, two Members of the Scout Fellowship in Berkshire - Betty and Peter Scurry - saw the needs of disabled children in Palissa. They have since worked and raised £15,000 to provide a Vocational Workshop for the Bulangira Disables Association. Hopefully this will be nearing completion when we visit in September 2004.
